NOTICE OF PLANNED BURNING

In our ongoing efforts to reduce the risk of wildfire to the community, the Shire of Mundaring Fire Protection Officers, in collaboration with local volunteer Bush Fire Brigades, are planning to carry out a prescribed hazard reduction burn at the reserve to the north of Chidlow Primary School in Chidlow. This burn is scheduled to occur in either the July or September school holidays 2026, contingent on suitable weather conditions.

The primary goal of this burn is to mitigate bushfire hazards and protect the community. We are committed to conducting this burn in the safest and most environmentally responsible manner possible, promoting the natural regeneration of native flora. However, please be aware that the burn may generate a significant amount of smoke, which could affect nearby properties.

Fire crews will closely monitor the burn, and patrols will continue for some time afterward to ensure safety. We advise residents to avoid entering the burn site for several days following the burn, as dead trees may pose a risk of falling or dropping limbs unexpectedly.
