Applications open on 21 April and close on Monday 22 May 2023 at 4pm.

Community Grant Keeps Wheels Inc. Turning



Just like Wheels Inc. who received a \$2000 matching grant, the Shire's Community Grants Program can support your group's projects in 2023.

Community Event Grants award up to \$5000 for groups to run activities from fetes, festivals, markets and sporting/recreational carnivals to exhibitions and small performances.

Matching Grants provide groups up to \$2000 to meet community needs driven projects including equipment, minor capital upgrades, promotional materials and training.

Welcome to SmartyFile



SmartyFile is a system for grant applicants to store their key contact information, files and other data.

SmartyFile will allow you to pre-fill

grant applications, safely allow multiple users to work on and manage applications. You will also be able to change the user of an application.

If you have a SmartyGrants login, you can access SmartyFile using the same login details. Once logged in, create a profile for your organisation, add your team members, assign them each a role, work with your team on applications across multiple funding bodies, and view all your applications in the one spot. When completing a grant application through SmartyGrants you can also pre-fill information from your organisation profile.
